

# TALENT SHOW GUIDELINES

1. Each act will have a time limit.
  - a. Vocal and Instrumental acts may be no longer than 3 minutes.
  - b. Dance acts may be no longer than 2 minutes.
  - c. Magic, Comedy, Gymnastics, Baton Twirling, and other, may be no longer than 1 minute.
  
2. All music must be turned in with your form by March 7th.
  - a. Music must be school appropriate.
  - b. Choose a song that fits the amount of time allotted for your act.
  - c. If you turn in music that is over the amount of time allotted, you will not be accepted.
  - d. Music may be turned in on a CD or a Flash Drive that Ms. Morris can briefly keep. Please have your name on your CD or Flash Drive.
  - e. No phones, video recordings, or Apple Music will be accepted.
  - f. If using music and music is not turned in with your form by the 7th, you will not be accepted.
  
3. Time slots may not be requested.
  
4. Students may only participate in 1 act.
  
5. Students wishing to participate in the Talent Show will audition during the school day on March 13th. Acts that are not fully prepared and ready to go will not be accepted.
  
6. Acts chosen to be in the Talent Show must be available to be at rehearsal on Thursday, March 21st from 3-4.
  
7. A parent/guardian must sign the talent show sign-up form. A signature verifies that the guidelines are understood.
