Reading-Mrs. Just

Students are using metacognition to think about their thinking, this includes monitoring their own comprehension. We will learn signals that indicate we don't understand a text -we call this a clunk and signals that we do understand -we call this a click.

Writing-Homeroom

Students are investigating the 6 traits of writing. This week we will focus on the trait of **organization**. Students will practice writing multiple types of introductions and will review components of a paragraph.
