The Spelling Activity List is in your child's Bee Binder. The students may choose once activity from this list each week for the Wednesday spelling homework.

Please remind your child to rotate through the activities instead of choosing the same activity each week. (Due on Thursday.)

Reading Logs -Read at home and return the completed Reading Log each Friday. A new log should be in the front pocket of your child's Bee Binder each Friday. The students are required to complete a minimum of four entries on the log each week. The four entries should be on different days.
