Science- We will share our dioramas this week. We are continuing our animal unit and looking at different habitats, adaptations, and doing a fun science activity this week.

Social Studies- We will be continuing practice with mapping skills.

Cursive- we have started cursive writing and practicing on the “clock climbers”. So far, they have learned a, d, c, g, and q. Have them show you their new writing. We will continue to practice this week and move to the next reading
