## WHAT'S HAPPENING THIS MONTH

### Reading

This month in reading, we will continue to focus on the big skill of segmenting and blending CVC words. We will also focus on phoneme substitution and deletion. We will also continue to work on sequence of events, characters and setting. These are great skills to review at home while reading at night with your child.

### Writing

This month in writing we will continue working on the same skills as last month. We will be incorporating sight words into our writing, stretching out words and writing them down. We will also focus on adding space between words. We will scaffold writing complete sentences with support.

### Math

The classes began the school year developing number concepts, now they are going to develop spatial reasoning and geometric concepts. The focus will be on two-dimensional and three-dimensional shapes and how their orientation and their relative positions to other objects can be different.

### Social Studies

In social studies this month, we will be comparing our Thanksgiving traditions today to Thanksgiving traditions long ago. We will also be making more broader comparisons to life in the past to life today and discussing how communities change over time.
