Curriculum:

Reading- Today, we read about Martin Luther King and responded to questions and wrote a topic paragraph about him. We will do other short readings and responses this week.

Writing- Along with journaling and response to literature, we are writing to inform about different topics and will do an on-demand practice.

Math- We are into Module 4. Students are learning other ways to subtract that can make problems easier to solve. Students are also solving 2 and 3 digit addition and subtraction problems in math packets. We are sharing different ways to arrive to the answers. MAPS testing tomorrow.

Science-We are continuing to learn about the 3 states matter and their characteristics. We will do some fun activities to reinforce the standards.
