Dear Parents,

Pik my kid does not list all my students and where they are going on one screen. If they are not sure or are not delegated where they usually are, then I have to find where they are supposed to go. If I am absent, another teacher will dismiss them, but they too will have to see where they are delegated. But the students need to make sure they are delegated where they think they are going! Example, your child is usually a walker, and they are not on the walker list, then the teacher needs to figure out where they go. Your child's safety is very important to me.

For homework this week, students will continue with reading log. I sent a math worksheet for tonight that is due tomorrow. They did one similar today. Watch for daily assignments in the planner. Students need to be reading an AR book at their level, and take a test each week unless they are reading a longer chapter book. I would like most students to be reading some type of chapter book sooner than later.

Curriculum:

Reading- We will be doing a variety of readings this week each day and doing some practice on IXL.

Writing- We are continuing to work informative writing and carrying other writing into our Science.

Math- We are over half way through our Module 4. Students are expected to be able to add and subtract 3 digit from a 2 digit numbers.

Science-We are wrapping up the 3 states matter. We will do some fun activities to show understanding.
