Content Area: ELA (Writing) Holt

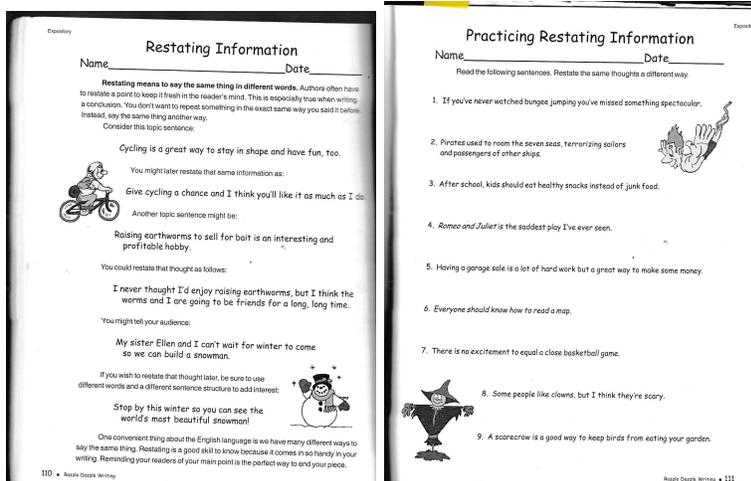
Learning Target: I understand why it is important to use my own words to restate information that I may have read or learned from another source, if I don't use quotation marks and/or footnotes.
