Can you build a ship using the criteria and constraints listed below?</p>	<p align="center"><i>“Treasure Island”</i></p> <p>Challenge: Pirate Pete wants to take some of his treasure from the mainland to his secret island before the sun comes up. His men are asleep on his boat so he has very few materials to use to build a boat. Can you build Pete a boat to carry his treasure safely to the island?</p>

Pennies (your weights)
Create: Make your boat using only the measured foil. Think about what shape will allow it to stay afloat and hold the most weight.
Test:
Put your boat in the water. Slowly add one penny at a time to your boat until it sinks. Remove your boat and pennies from water and count how many pennies it held before capsizing. 1 penny= 2.5 grams (or .088 ounces)
How much weight did your boat hold?
Improve: How can you change the design of your boat to hold more weight? Take another piece of foil, improve your design and test it again.
How much weight did it hold this time?

Materials:
Foil, clay, pipe cleaners, straws, string, index cards, 12 inches of tape, scissors, large container at least 12 inches across filled with water, pennies (cargo)
Criteria and Constraints:
1- Ship can not be larger than 6 inches in any direction.
2- May use any of the materials listed above to make your ship.
3- Your empty ship must be able to sail from one side of your container across to the other side (a minimum of 12 inches) without taking on any water or sinking.
4- Ship must be able to carry as much load (pennies) as possible without taking on water or sinking.
5- You may not touch the ship once it is placed in the water.
6- You only have 15 minutes to build your Ship.
Test: Slowly add pennies to your ship until it takes on water or sinks.
Improve: How much cargo did your ship carry?
1 penny=2.5 grams (or .088 oz)
How would you improve the design of your ship to carry more cargo?
Try it out!

Materials:
1 piece of foil 6 inches x 6 inches
Large container filled with water (or a sink)
Pennies (weights)
Criteria and Constraints:
1- You may use only the specified amount of foil listed above to make your boat.
2- You may not touch your boat once it is placed in the water.
3- Your boat is considered unsafe when it takes on water or sinks.
Test: Slowly add pennies (weight) to your boat until it starts to take on water or sinks (whichever happens first).
Improve: How much treasure was your boat able to hold?
1 penny=2.5 grams (or .088 oz)
How would you improve the design of your boat to help Pirate Pete carry more treasure?
Try it out!
